WASHING PROCEDURES

A) Washing

- 1. Before start washing, check the following;
- Connect the water supply hose and open the water tap.
- Connect the power cord to the power supply outlet.
- Lay the drain hose down toward a sinkhole.
- 2. Set the WASH SELECTOR KNOB to the desired mode.
- Set from options Gentle, Normal and Strong.
- 3. Set the DRAIN SELECTOR KNOB to 'WASH/RINSE'.
- 4. Set the WATER SELECTOR KNOB to 'WASH'.
- 5. Load laundry in the wash tub.

6. Fill water in the wash tub and add the detergent.

7. Set the WASH TIMER.

- Set the Wash Timer 1-35 min. (Set the Wash Timer to a point between 15 to 35 mins for soak function).

SOAK FUNCTION If the WASH TIMER is set to a point between "15" to "35", the washing machine start the wash, after the soak (20 mins) is completed.

 After washing, set the DRAIN SELECT OR KNOB to 'DRAIN' for drain.

RINSING & DRYING A) Rinsing 1. Set the DRAIN SELECTOR KNOB to WASH/RINSE 2. Supply the proper amount of water as not to overflow the top of the washing tub. 3. Set the WASH TIMER 2~3 minutes. 4. Drain the water. Set the DRAIN SELECTOR KNOB to 'DRAIN'. 5. Repeat this cycle until drain water is clean.(2~3 cycles). DRAIN SELECTOR 6. Be sure to lay the drain hose down. B) Additional Rinse 1. Load Laundry - Load the laundry evenly into the spin basket. 2. Set DRAIN Set the WATER SELECTOR KNOB to SPIN(a) and DRAIN SELECTOR KNOB to 'DRAIN'(b) 3. Supply Water Supply water for about 1 minute. Adjust the water flow to prevent overflow from the wash tub. 4. Safety Cover After stopping water supply, cover the laundry with safety cover and close the inner lid. SAFETY COVER 5. Close the spin dryer - Close the spin dryer lid. 6. Set SPIN TIMER - Set the SPIN TIMER for 2~3 minutes. C) Drying 1. Transfer the clothes into the spin basket and arrange clothes evenly . 2. Be sure to attach the safety cover and close the inner lid. 3. Close the spin dryer lid. 3. Set the SPIN TIMER - Set timer between 1~5 min for drying. SPIN TIMER _ 5 -----

CLEANING MACHINE	
A) Cleaning MAGIC FILTER	
1. Push the upper part of the Magic filter and pull in.	
2. Open the cover as shown in figure	
3. Clean the Magic Filter	
4. Close the cover and insert the lower 'A ' part of the filter in the basket first and push the filter from upper part 'B' with "click" sound.	B


TROUBLE	CHECKPOINT
The washing machine does not work.	 Is the power supply cord connected to a power outlet? Is the power cut ? Is the pulsator tangled with something?
Unable to drain	Has the Drain Hose been lowered?Is the Drain Hose blocked?Is the Drain Hose kinked?
Abnormal sound during wash.	Are there any loose articles in the Wash Tub?
Incomplete spinning (Severe vibration or unbalance)	 Are the laundry arranged evenly? Is the machine being placed on a flat and solid ground? Are there any clothes dangling on the Spin Tub? Are there too many laundry in the Spin Tub?

MAINTENANCE


*Note

Please unplug the power supply cord before clean-up.

- 1. After you have washed the clothes, keep the door of machine open to let the moisture and dampness dry out. If your have washed very greasy and dirty load, make sure to clean the machine and tub with a damp clothe to remove any slimy build up.
- 2. There will be lint left behind in the Magic Filter after each use which need to be cleaned frequently to maintain its top performance.
- 3. Clean the machine with a soft damp cloth.
- 4. Do not spray water directly onto the machine.
- 5. Do not use petroleum-based detergent to clean the machine.
- Overloading the machine may stop your laundry from washing properly, unbalance the machine and reduce spin efficiency. Take particular care when washing heavier or bulkier items such as towels or bedding.
