6. The switch will pop up when the rice is done. And the light will switch from the cook to warm which indicates that the warm function is working.	- The "warm" function continues until unplugged.
7. After the switch pops up. Leave the lid closed for at least 15 minutes to steam rice.	
8. Fluff the rice.	- If the rice seems sticky, it is not fluffed
9. Unplug after use.	

HOW TO CLEAN

Unplug before cleaning.


- 1. Soak the pan in lukewarm water and wash with a sponge.
- 2. Wipe the body with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the unit in water.
- 3. Do not use abrasive cleaners or steel wool. Clean with non-metal brush or sponge.

TO KEEP COOKED RICE WARM AND TASTY

- Wash the rice with water. Please note remove the pan during washing.
- Using "keep warm" function more than 12 hours may cause discoloration or an objectionable order in the rice.
- Do not mix cold rice after cooking.
- Do not leave the utensils in the pan once cooking is done, because that may destroy the taste of rice.
- Paper located between the pan and the heating plate should be removed before use.

Do not cover the lid with the cloth. The lid may deform or change color.

Always keep the pan and the heating plate clean. Any foreign matter between them will cause your cooker to malfunction.




- Do not cover the lid with your hands or place your face directly over the steam coming from the cooker.
- If the supply cord is damaged, we must use either the special-purpose flexible cord or the special-purpose module.



RECEIPE FOR COOKING RICE

Step 1: Open the lid

Step 2: Take the inner pan out.

Step 3: Measure the rice using the measuring cup provided.

Note: Do not exceed the quantities indicated on the inside of the inner pan.

Step 4: Wash the rice thoroughly.

Step 5: You can add ghee/oil and even Cumin seeds (Jeera) according to your preference. Put the pre-washed rice in the inner pan.

Step 6: Add water to the level indicated on the scale inside the inner pan that corresponds to the number of cups of rice used.

Step 7: Then smoothen the rice surface.

Step 8: Put the inner pan in the appliance. Check if the inner pan is in proper contact with the heating element. Note: Make sure that the outside of the inner pan is dry and clean and that there is no foreign residue on the heating element or the magnetic switch.

Step 9: Close the lid of the appliance, and plug in the appliance to the main voltage.

Step 10: Plug-in and the "Power lamp socket" will light. Then press down switch lightly, it will move to "cook".

Step 11: Once the rice has been cooked, the appliance will automatically switch to Keep Warm' mode.

Tip: Open the lid and stir the rice to loosen it for best results. Do this just after the appliance has switched to 'Keep Warm' mode. Then close the lid firmly. Stirring the rice allows the excess steam to escape, and give fluffier rice.
