



PARTS IDENTIFICATION:

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS:

1. Make sure that the washing machine is plugged to a 3 pin/5A electrical outlet with earth terminal.

2. Unplug the power supply cord when not in use.

3. To disconnect the washing machine from electrical mains , pull out the plug. Ensure you do not pull it directly from the cord.

4. Don't allow kids near the washing machine while in use.

5. This washing machine is meant for washing clothes with water as a medium.

Do not use petrol or other chemicals. This can result in fire and damage.

6. Do not use water with temperature exceeding 50 degree celcius, as this deforms the plastic parts in the machine. If you desire to use warm water, add hot water to cold water in the wash tub. Do not pour hot water in an empty tub/spin basket directly.

7. Keep the machine away from flames and inflammable material. Do not expose the washing machine to direct sunlight or rain. Also avoid placing it in humid locations.

8. Take precautions not to pierce the control panel.

9. Do not press the button with an awl or a pin.

10. Avoid overloading of wash and spin tub.

11. Do not use wash and spin tub for water storage.

CARE & MAINTENANCE:

Be sure to remove the power plug from main power supply before cleaning the machine.

CLEANING THE WASH TUB:

After wash, fill fresh water above the level of pulsator without adding clothes.
 Run the machine for 1-2 minutes, turn the knob to 'drain' position when pulsator is still rotating.

3. When water is completely drained out, turn the knob to 'wash' position.

4. Finally, turn off the machine.

RECOMMENDED WASHING PROCEDURE:

RINSING:

1. Rinse: Fill the wash tub appropriately depending on the number of clothes being washed. Set wash timer for 15 minutes. Rinse will begin and clothes will rinse for a period of the same period of time.

2. Spin Rinse: Put clothes inside the Spin Tub. Set water supply selected to 'Spin Tub'. Open the water tap and keep it open for 1 to 2 minutes and then close the tap. Spin for a minute. When rinsing is over, set the Drian Selector to 'Drain'. Do not keep the water tap open when the Spin tub is rotating to avoid the maching from malfunctioning.

SPIN DRYING:

Put clothes inside the Spin Tub. In order to prevent the machine from malfunctioning, distribute them evenly and ensure that the drain hose is lowered. After this, place spin tub cap over the clothes inside the tub to prevent them from flying out. Close the lid of the spin tub. (If the lid is not closed it will not rotate.) Set the 'Spin Timer' from 1 to 5 minutes according to the type of clothes. If the spin tub starts shaking noticeably, open the lid and wait for it to stop spinning. Distribute the clothes evenly and re-start.

NOTES:

- In order to prevent clothes from damaging and to prevent water splash, make sure that there is a balance between wash load and the water volume.

- The quantity of wash load varies depending on fabric type, thickness and size of the clothes.

- Adjust the water level/wash load as required by carefully watching the movement of the clothes in the tub.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE:

TROUBLES	CHECK POINTS
Motor not working	 Check supply source. Is the power cord firmly plugged in? Is the timer turned to a suitable point except "OFF"? Motor has been provided with "TOP" (Thermal overload protector). This will protect the motor from burning due to overheating caused by various variable factors such as overload voltage, frequency variation, etc. In such case motor supply will get off, thus stopping the motor. Wait for approximate ½ hour till motor cools to normal temperature. Restart the M/c to see if motor functions normally.
Spin dryer basket does not operate	 Is there any cloth dropped between the basket and tub? Is the spin dryer cover closed? Is the laundry gathered to one side of the spin dryer basket?
Drain not drawing	 Is the lint stuck to the plunger valve? Is the end of the drain hose guide located at an excessive height?

TROUBLESHOOTING TABLE:

Problem	Reason	Solution
The pulsator does not rotate	Power out or switch off Transmission belt burst Pulsator is blocked by something	Switch on plug Assemble the transmission belt Remove the blockage
The pulsator rotates too slowly	Belt becomes loose The flexible screw of motor is loose	Tighten the belt or replace it Tighten the belt and the screw
Abnormal noise and vibration	The clothes in the spin-dry tub are unbalanced Something was stuck between pulsator and wash tub	Place the dothes neatly Remove it.
Water leaks from wash tub	The hose is not tightened with the wash tub	Tighten it

Usage instructions for semi-automatic washing machine. Step 1:

- Select the wash option (Normal/Gentle) on the selector switch.
- Put clothes in the wash tub with water and detergent.
- Once wash cycle has started, clothes will be washed for 15 min.

Step 2:

- Put in the clothes in the spin tub.
- Select spin timer for the time period required (5 minutes).
- This is required to remove excess soap.
- This will result in the first drying process for the clothes.

Step 3:

- Transfer clothes to the wash tub.
- Rinsing: Fill in water only and select wash time for 3-4 minutes.
- After this is complete, select the drain mode to drain out water.


Step 4:

- Drying: Transfer clothes to spin tub and select spin time to complete the final drying process.
