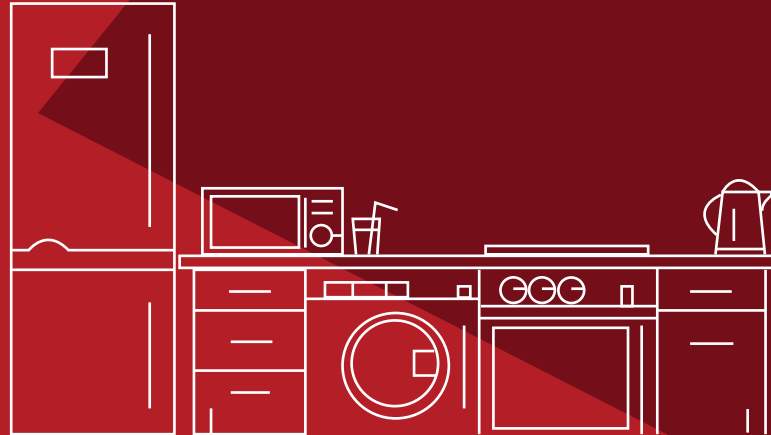

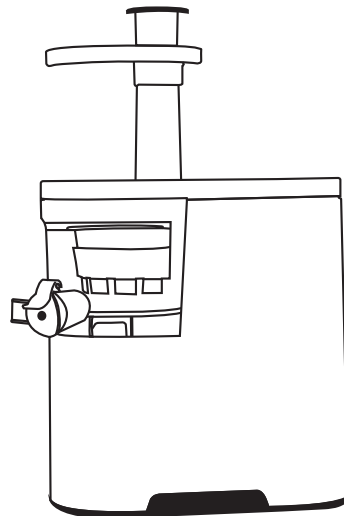

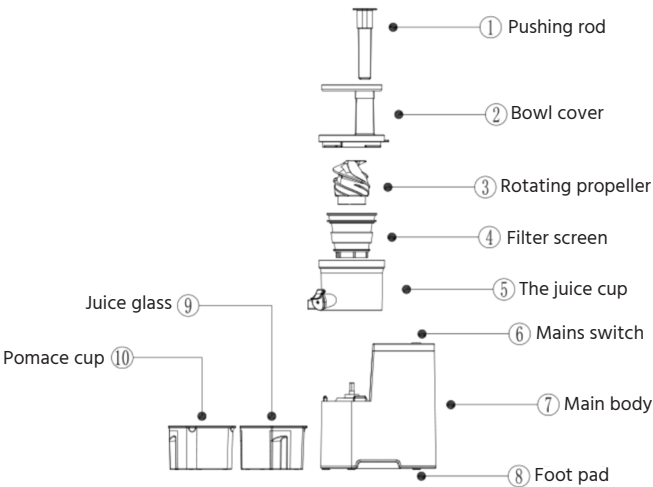

ABOUT THE PRODUCT:

The Lifelong Slow Juicer’s Slow squeeze juicing technology enables maximum juice extraction and ensures maximum nutrient preservation. This product is characterised by the novel design, high juice yield, pomace separation, shock absorption, and low noises, which is conveniently used in the kitchen. Squeezed juicing is a pure natural technology that completely reserves the natural taste, and nutrient of foods, with lasting squeezing like stone mills and gentle operation as using hands when making green juice and fruit juice.

PRECAUTIONS BEFORE USE:

1. Read all instructions before using.
2. To protect against risk of electrical shock, do not put main body (motor) in water or any liquid.
3. Children should be supervised to ensure that they do not play with the appliance.
4. Do not operate any appliance with damaged cord or plug or after the appliance malfunctions or is dropped or damaged in any manner. Return appliance to the nearest authorized service facility for examination, repair or electrical or mechanical adjustment.
5. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.
6. Unplug from outlet when not in use, before assembling or taking off parts and before cleaning.
7. Avoid contact of moving parts.

8. Do not use attachments not recommended or sold by the manufacturer may as it may lead to fire, electric shock or injury.
9. Always ensure your switch the juicer to the off position and the motor has stopped completely before disassembling.
10. Do not your fingers or foreign into the juicer while it is in operation. If food becomes lodged in the inlet use the plunger to push it down or use the reverse button on the machine to dislodge it. If this is not possible turn the juicer off and for the motor to completely stop before disassembling the juicer to remove food.
11. Do not use outdoors.
12. Do not use appliance for other than intended purpose.
13. Lift appliance with the handle only.
14. Do not put any parts into the dishwasher.

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:

Important: Prior to Assembling the juicer, please check this point: At the base of the bowl there is a rubber stopper. When in place the stopper ensures all the juice only exits via the juice outlet. Before Juicing always ensure that the rubber stopper is firmly in place.

1. Assemble the bowl on the base.
 - A. Make sure the bowl is all the way into the shaft of the base.
2. Insert the strainer into the spinning brush. Align the red dot on the strainer with the red dot on the bowl and insert strainer +spinning brush into the bowl. When the dots are correctly aligned the strainer +spinning brush will lock in place.
3. Insert the squeezing screw into the strainer and turn until it drops into position.
4. Assemble the hopper onto the bowl.

- A. Align the small arrow on the hopper with the red dot on the bowl.
- B. Twist the hopper so that the plastic tab with the arrow on it points to the closed sign on the base.

Note: The small arrow from part 4.A will no longer be aligned with the red dot once the hopper is locked to the close position.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS: IMPORTANT:

- Do not operate the juicer with wet hands as it may cause an electric shock.
 - Do not operate the juicer prior to inputting juicing materials.
 - Do not operate for more than 30 minutes at one time.
1. Plug in the juicer.
 2. Place a container below the juicer outlet and a container below the pulp outlet.
 3. The juicer power button (located at the upside of the handle) has 3 positions.
 - A. ON-This starts the motor and juicing process.
 - B. OFF-Is the central position of the button. It switches off the appliance.
 - C. REV-Is reverse. Only use this function when something is stuck in the juicer and it needs to be unclogged.
 4. Insert the material you wish to juice into the hopper.
 - Ensure pieces are not larger than 4cm for optimal juicer extraction.
 - Remove any large pips or seeds.
 - Always pre-wash food before juicing.
 - Do not overstuff the hopper or force food in. Insert food slowly to allow juicer time to work. The pusher is only to be used if food becomes stuck.

5. Switch the power button to "ON".
 - Insert food slowly to allow juicer time to work.
 - Do not overstuff the hopper or force food in. The pusher is only to be used if food becomes stuck.
6. When you are finished switch the power button to 'OFF'.

A. IF THE MACHINE BECOMES CLOGGED AND INOPERABLE.

1. Turn the machine off and press the reverse button for a few seconds then try operating again.
Note: The reverse button works with a 'pulse' motion.
2. If the reverse button does not work turn off the machine and switch off at the power point. Disassemble the unit to dislodge any material then reassemble as per the instructions and try again.

DEVICE CLEANING:

1. Switch off the unit.
2. Twist the bowl and hopper as one piece to the right so that the arrow on the hopper moves away from the close position. Lift off.
3. Disassemble the parts in the order show by the diagram.
4. Use the brush to clean all these parts thoroughly in warm soapy water then dry thoroughly.
5. Use a damp cloth to wipe down the base of the unit.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

Terms and Conditions:

1. This warranty is void if:
 - a. The completely filled warranty card is not presented at the time of servicing the product.
 - b. The product is not operated according to the instructions given under the user manual.
 - c. Damages are caused by lightning, abnormal voltage, water or other liquid intrusion, fire, flood, accident, negligence or improper handling.
 - d. Product has been damaged due to installation, repairs, alterations or modifications by unauthorized service organizations or persons.
 - e. Product label specifying the model number, serial number and production code has been removed and altered.
 - f. Defects or parts requiring replacement due to ordinary wear and tear, corrosion, rust or stains, scratches, dents on the casing or paintwork of the product.
 - g. Claims damaged and/or missing parts (accessories) after 7 days from the original date of goods received.
 - h. Defects or faults in product which have been used for commercial/industrial purposes or which have been rented/leased or have been otherwise subject to non-household/non-domestic use.
2. Repairs or replacements will be carried out by authorized service provider.
3. During the limited warranty period, Lifelong or its authorized service provider will repair without charge the defective unit inclusive of labor and parts and restore the unit to its optimum working condition. All defective parts used for the warranty repair should be surrendered to Lifelong and/or its authorised servicer.
4. All expenses incurred in collecting the unit (s) or part(s) thereof from authorised service provider as well as any other expenses and incidentals will be borne by the consumer.

5. Lifelong obligations are limited to the repair and replacement of the defective product. Except as set forth above, there are no other express or implied warranty and all warranted, conditions or other terms implied by statute or common law (including any warranty of satisfactory quality, merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose) are excluded to the fullest extent permitted by the law.
6. Lifelong total liability for damages relating to or arising out of the purchase or use of the product regardless of the type or cause of such damage of the form of characterization of the claim asserted (e.g. contract or tort) shall not exceed the original purchase price paid for the product.
